



Information and Application for BLDATF Christmas Programme Budget

BLDATF welcomes applications for the Christmas Programme Budget. This budget is open to TF funded and non-TF funded agencies (organisations must be a constituted group with their own bank account and charity/company number). The aim of this budget is to support local community organisations and groups to run programmes over the Christmas period which will help reduce isolation, support families and to strengthen community and social engagement over the December-January period.

Applications up to €500 will be considered.

Please note there is no guarantee of the full amount requested being awarded.

Please note this is a one off fund, there is no guarantee of further funding for this activity.

Fund guidelines and criteria

1. Programme budget for innovative Christmas Programmes running over Christmas Holiday period only.
2. Programmes need to demonstrate how they are adhering to government guidelines in relation Covid-19.

Conditions

- All activities must be completed by 31st January 2023– no extensions will be applied.
- Only one application per project is permitted.
- Any monies which are allocated but not spent will need to be reimbursed to the BLDATF.
- Additional supporting documentation may be requested before any funds are allocated.
